## The Conference Venue -**Cruise Terminal 2**

Long considered the 'Port of Kings', Dover has been a royal gateway for centuries and the origins of this strategically important port can be traced back to Roman times as is evident in the 1st century Pharos that overlooks the harbour.

The conference will be held in Cruise Terminal 2 which is located at the seaward end of Admirally Pier at the western end of the port. It offers unrivalled views across the harbour towards the busy Eastern Docks, the infamous white cliffs and the imposing seafront, all of which are dominated by the giant fortress that is Dover Castle, otherwise known as the 'Key to England'.
